Can you see the lines? What could you use to make them easier to see?

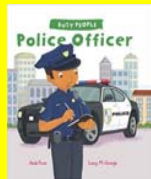
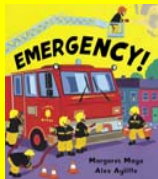
## Literacy
