Mornings/End of the day



- Please bring your child to the school door in the middle of the playground, where a member of staff will greet them.
- Children will hang their belongings on their peg and put book bags into their drawers.
- Any sandwich boxes will be placed on the trolley near the classroom.

Snack

Reading, Diaries and Word sets



- Children are encouraged to change their own reading books when they enter school in the morning.
- Please make a comment in your child's diary when they have read to you. We ask that you read everyday with your child for 10-15 minutes. This may also be playing word games and using books on bug club. Please sign their dairy to communicate with us the reading activities your child is engaging with.
- Each time your child moves a book band a leaflet will be put into their diary, giving to you information about the next steps in reading.

Our online reading programme.

- Your child will have come home with log in details to access their online world and eBooks.
- Please write in your child's diary when they have read an eBook.
- Has your child logged on to bug club this term? Please let us know of any difficulties.



Reading Challenge!

- Every week we ask the children to take part in our reading challenge.
- The challenge is to read 4 or 5 times a week.
- There must be a comment in their diary to indicate the days they have read.
- Reading on Bug Club can be recorded in your child's reading diary.

Mathletics

Mathletics

Your child will be allocated maths homework on mathletics each week. These activities will consolidate learning in class. Points are awarded for every correct answer and these will help your child to earn certificates. Certificate are awarded in school each week. There are also games to play that helps develop your child's mathematical fluency.

1,000 points within a week (Sunday to Sunday) = 1 bronze certificate 5 bronze certificates = 1 silver certificate 4 silver certificates = 1 gold certificate

- Bug club books will be added for your child each week.
- Please note that there are only a certain amount of books allocated for each book band. Children should be encouraged to read their hard copy books as well.
