We arrived at Edgmond hall and got ready for our first adventure of the day.....



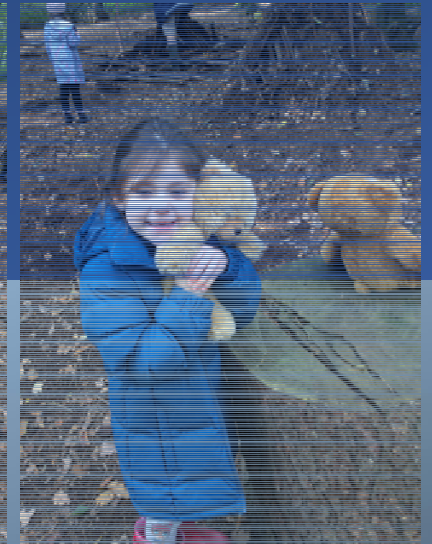
Teddy Bear Hunt

We were very hungry after such a busy day!

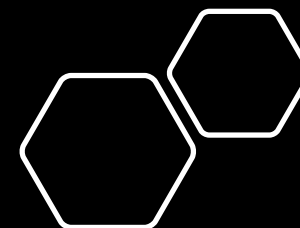




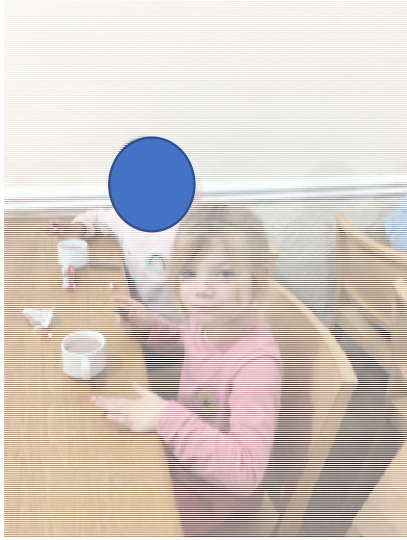

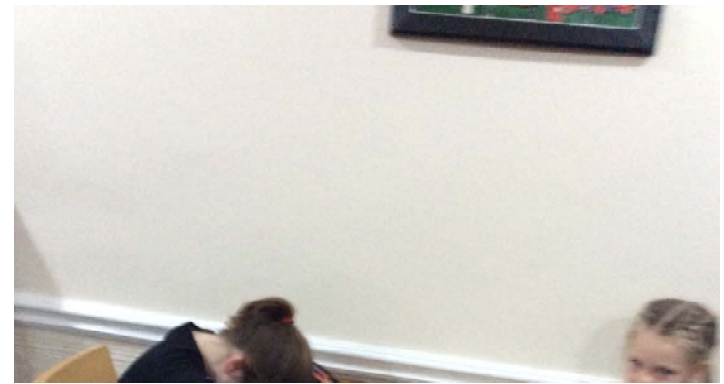


We went for a torch walk into the woods. It was very dark!
