Census Day and Universal Infant Free School Meal

Dear Parents / Carers,

RE: Census Day and Universal Infant Free School Meal 'Pizza Buffet' Thursday 3 October 2024.

On Thursday 3 October 2024, it is National School Census Day.

To maximise our potential funding, we are encouraging all families with children entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meal to enjoy their free meal on Thursday 3 October, rather than bringing a packed lunch that day. This is every child in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

It is the amount of children in Key Stage One eating the free meal on the census day lunchtime that informs our school funding. Pupils who bring a packed lunch from home unfortunately are not able to be included, nor are children who normally take Universal Infant Free School Meal, but who are absent on 3 October.

Please can we encourage as many as possible to commit to eating the school dinner on Thursday 3 October as this will ensure our school receives the best possible funding for the year!

The Nest School Readiness Drop-in Session

A member of the School Readiness Health Visiting Team will be available on **Wednesday 2 October at drop off times**. (8.45am and 12.15pm) in the Nest.

The health visiting team are their to give you advice, support, and signpost to resources on toileting, behaviour, sleep, fussy eating and dental health. By identifying development concerns early, support, targeted interventions and early referrals can be put in place to ensure your child is equipped and ready for school.

School Admissions 2025



Reception & Junior Applications

For Reception or those transferring from Infant to Junior (Year 3) in September 2025, applications will be available via the Telford & Wrekin website from **12th September 2024**.

All parents will need to apply via the <u>parent portal</u>.

How to apply for a place in Year 3 in September 2025 (Infant to Junior transfer)

As your child is attending an infant school, you will need to apply for a junior school place in Year 3 for September 2025. To apply for a junior school place you must apply online at www.telford.gov.uk/admissions.

The closing date for all applications is **15 January 2025** or **31 October 2024** for children with an Education, Health and Care Plan. If you do not have access to a computer, you can go to your local library and use their computer facilities.

Closing date for applications:

15 January 2025

If your child has an Education, Health & Care Plan (EHCP) the closing date is 31 October 2024.

www.telford.gov.uk/admissions

- You must apply if your child was born between 1 September 2020 – 31 August 2021.
- You must apply even if your child is attending a nursery or preschool on a school site or you have a child already attending the school.
- You are advised to list four schools on your application form, including your catchment area/nearest school.
- Attending a nursery does **not** guarantee a school place.
- School places are allocated in line with oversubscription criteria.


