Dear Parents and Carers,



Keep Your Info Secret!

Don't share your full name, address, phone number, or school online. Stay

Ask Before You Share

Always ask a parent or adult before posting pictures or personal info.

Set Screen Time Limits

Too much screen time isn't good! Make sure you take breaks and play outside, too!

Talk to a Grown-Up

If something feels wrong or makes you uncomfortable online, tell a trusted adult.

Be Kind Online

Treat others with respect! If you see bullying, speak up or tell an adult.

Only Accept Friends You Know

Don't talk to strangers online. Only connect with people you know in real life.

Use Kid-Friendly Websites

Look for websites and games that are safe for kids. Ask an adult for help finding them!

Think Before You Click

Not everything online is true! Double-check and ask an adult if you're unsure.

Be Smart About Social Media

Keep your social media profiles private and only share with people you know.

Always Ask for Help

If you ever have a question or feel unsure online, ask an adult!
