WHAT IS GRAFFITI ART?

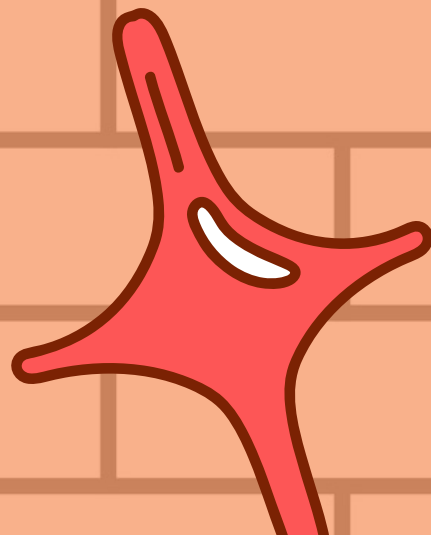
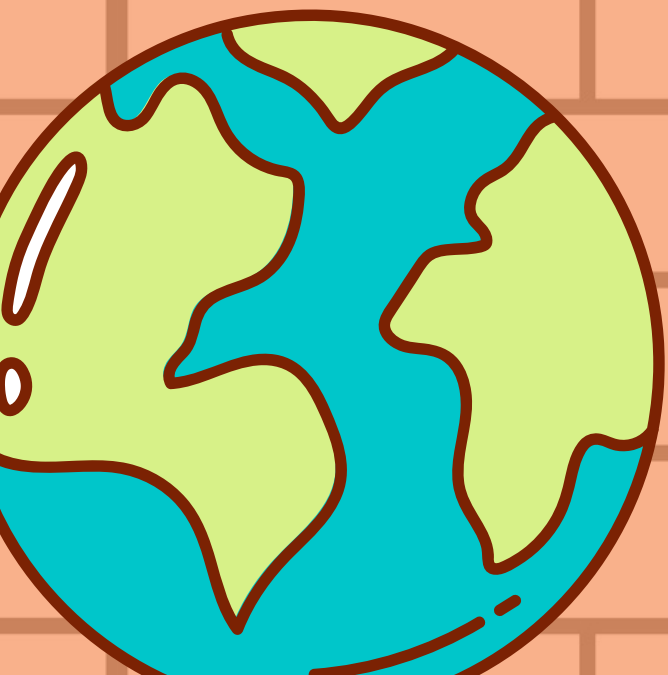


Graffiti art is a form of street art that involves painting or drawing on public surfaces, often using spray paint. It can be artistic and decorative.



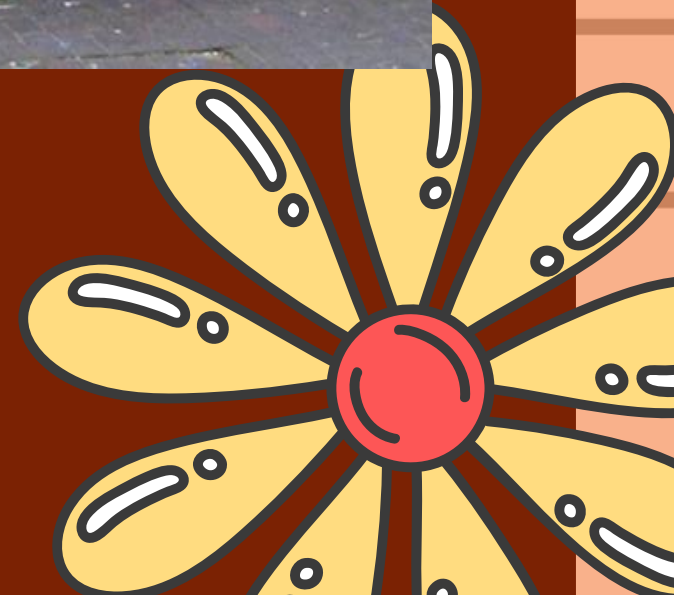
Graffiti art can be very colourful and creative, but we can't just paint on walls anywhere we like. If we want to create art on a wall, we need to ask for permission first. Painting on walls without permission is not allowed and can make places look messy. Instead, we can use paper, card, or special areas where art is welcome!

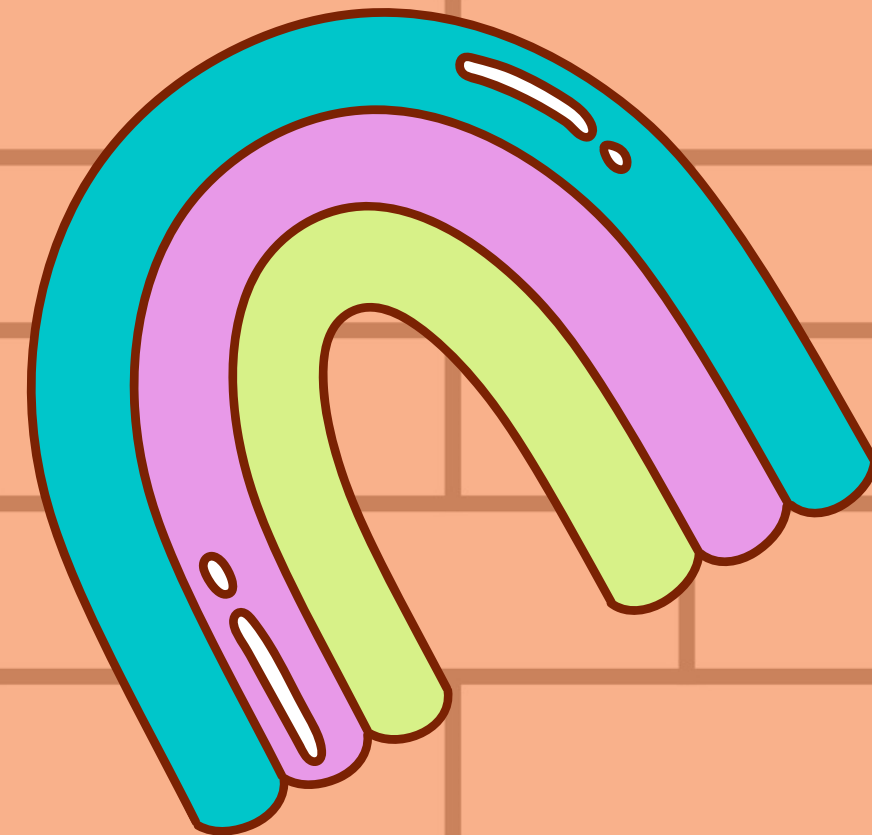

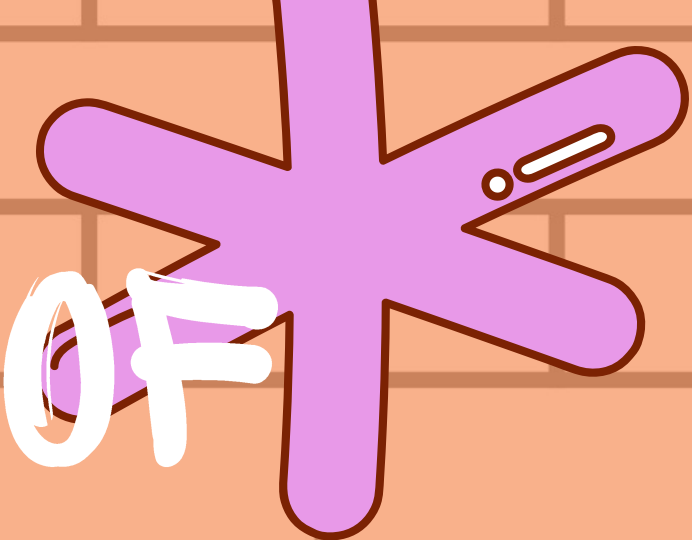


At the end of the Summer Term, Neil Willis a local Graffiti Artist will be painting a graffiti mural to represent our school on the wall in the playground.

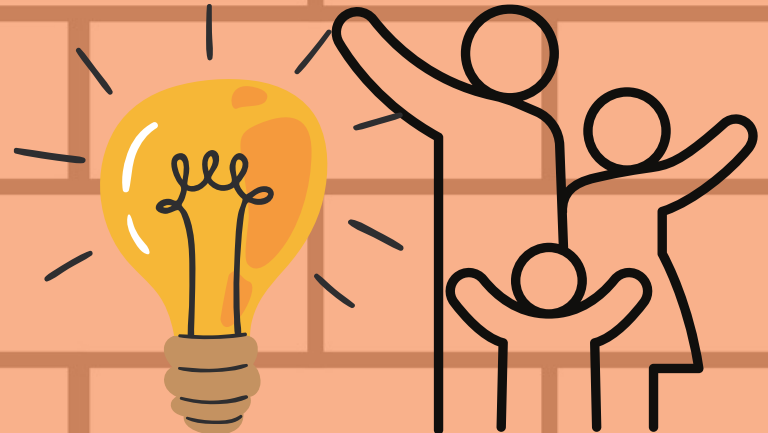
During assembly today we decided on this wall on the playground so all children, staff and families can see it everyday.

We need your ideas about what we should include and what you think our school is all about. Here are some ideas.

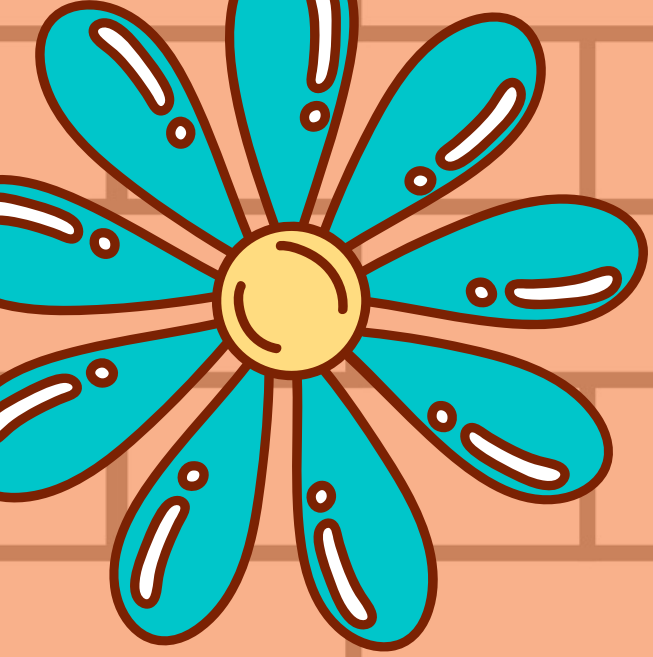


During assembly lots of children suggested our motto 'Love, Laugh, Learn' and the birds that represent each class. What else can you think of?
