Our children have truly thrived, they have grown in confidence, character, and are learning so much, and I couldn't be prouder of the progress they've made across our amazing school.

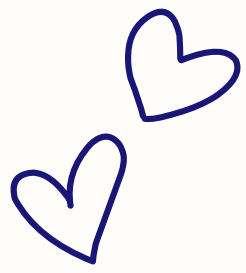

# Good Luck Luck Miss Nicholls

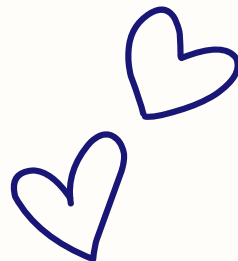
**As the school year draws to a close, we would like to take a moment to thank Miss Nicholls for her hard work and dedication as our Nursery teacher.**

# Grand Opening of Sparrows Classroom

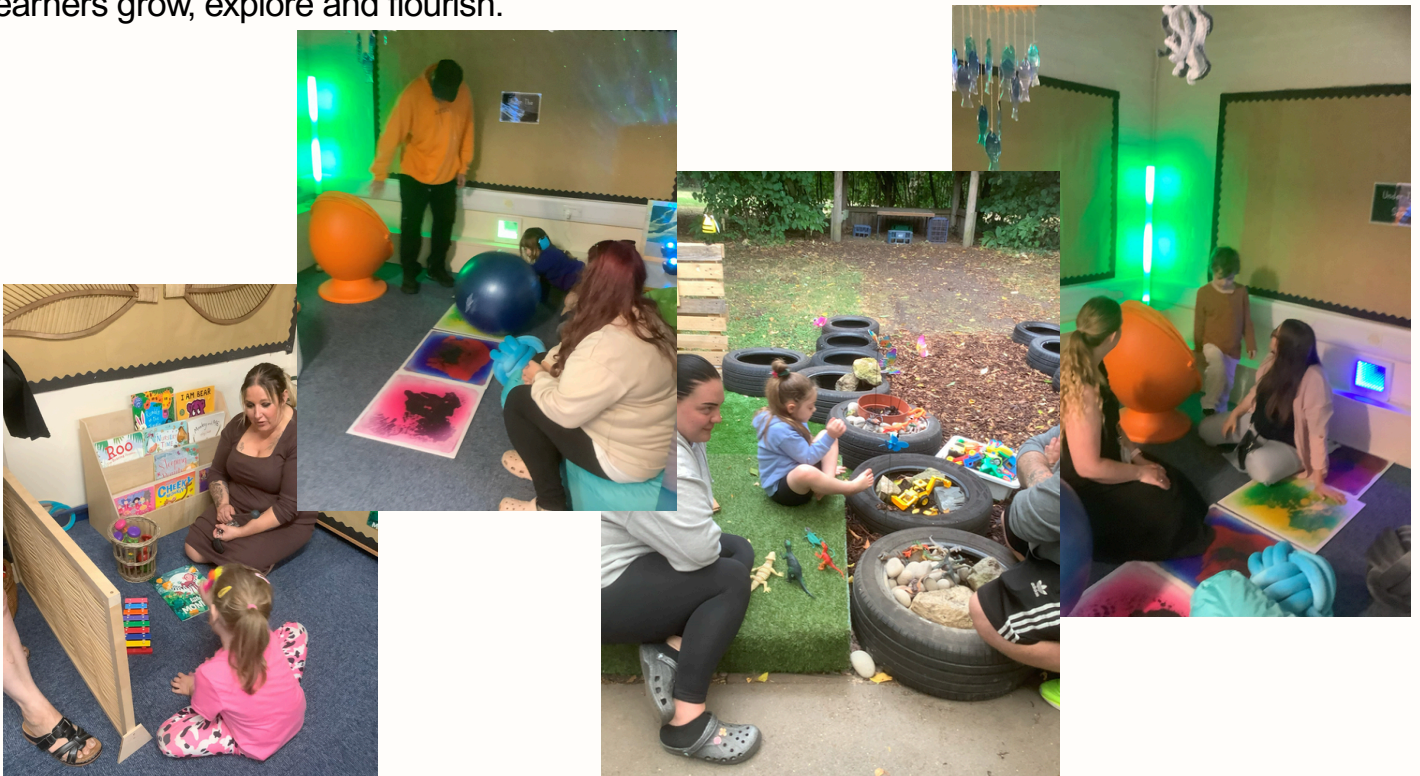
## Exciting News: Our Sparrows Classroom Opens This September!

We can't wait to see the Sparrows Classroom come to life in September and watch these young learners grow, explore and flourish.







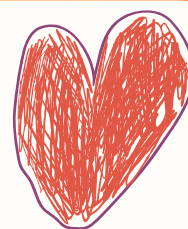
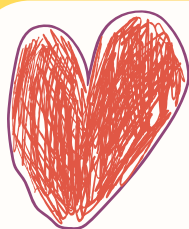

# Goodbye Year 2



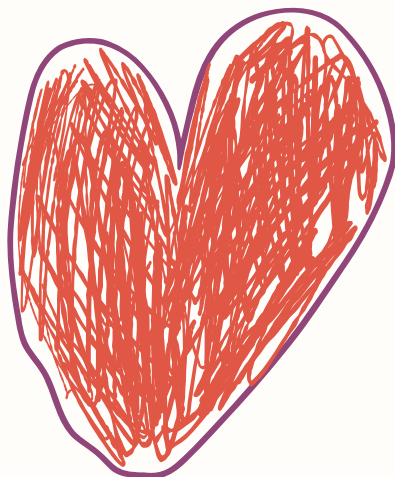
**What a wonderful way to end the term for our Year 2 children.**

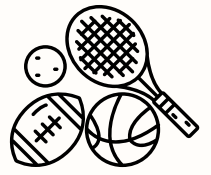
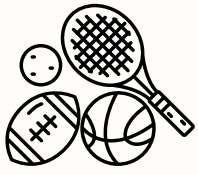
